- DRESS WARMLY AND KEEP A BLANKET IN THE VEHICLE
- CHARGE YOUR CELLULAR PHONE PRIOR TO DEPARTURE
- CLEAR OFF ALL VEHICLE WINDOWS AND LIGHTS
- FILL YOUR TANK IN THE EVENT YOU ARE STRANDED
- USE AN ANTI-ICE SOLUTION WINDSHIELD WASHER FLUID
- PUT TOGETHER A KIT OF WEATHER-RELATED ESSENTIALS





- LEAVE EARLIER THAN NEEDED IN CASE OF TRAVEL DELAYS
- REDUCE YOUR SPEED IN WINTERY CONDITIONS
- TURN ON YOUR VEHICLE'S HEADLAMPS FOR VISIBILITY
- INCREASE DISTANCE BETWEEN VEHICLES FOR STOPPING
- BE MORE CAUTIOUS ON BRIDGES AND OVERPASSES
- AVOID USING CRUISE CONTROL DUE TO SLIPPERY SURFACES
